


RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Vice Chairman Alvino Hawkins advises the Tribal Council that Tribal members have requested that the Tribe investigate the feasibility of establishing a Tribal Credit Union for tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Vice Chairman requests authorization from the Tribal Council to review this request and to preliminarily investigate the feasibility of establishing a Credit Union on the reservation.

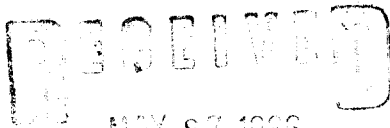
BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Vice-Chairman to review the feasibility of establishing a reservation based Credit Union.

The foregoing resolution was on May 15, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the tribe, ratified by the Tribe pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
