

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reconsidered its prior resolution prohibiting members of the Tribal Council from appearing on Radio Station KNNB, said Resolution having been passed prior to the 1986 tribal elections; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is presently of the opinion that there is a need to provide information regarding Tribal Council decisions and policies to the Tribal Community and that the Radio Station, having a widespread listening audience, could best disseminate information in the native language; and

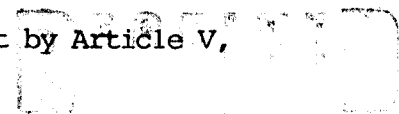
WHEREAS, in order to fulfill its basic responsibilities to its constituency concludes that members of the Tribal Council should be allowed to present their reports according to the prior schedule, specifically, that the Chairman and Vice-Chairman report on Tuesdays and Thursdays and that Tribal Council Members report on Saturday on a rotating basis; and

WHEREAS, if any Council Member cannot appear, no substitute will be allowed to make the presentation for him or her on the Radio Station and that all presentations made by the members of the Council shall abide strictly to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) regulations, and be confined to reports of a public rather than personal nature.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes members of the Tribal council to appear on the KNNB Radio Station for the purpose of providing public information on Council affairs and issues to members of the KNNB listening audience on the condition that no substitutes will be allowed to make a report for members of the Council who are unable to attend and that said reports shall be confined to public information and not personal matters.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman and Vice Chairman shall be reporting on Tuesdays and Thursdays and that all other tribal council members shall make their radio reports on Saturdays on a rotating basis.


The foregoing resolution was on May 15, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of
