

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Game and Fish Department have a duty to protect the wildlife of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and


WHEREAS, the Game and Fish Department has information that alleged poaching occurred during the San Carlos Apache Tribe non-member big game hunt season; and

WHEREAS, the Game and Fish Department believes a reward will assist in bringing forward witnesses.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby offers a \$5,000.00 reward for information that will lead to the arrest and conviction of all people involved.

The foregoing resolution was on May 21, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
