

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the North Fork Livestock Association has requested permission from the Tribal Council to utilize the new Tribal Fair Grounds on May 31 and June 1, 1986 for the North Fork Livestock Association sponsored rodeo; and

WHEREAS, said rodeo has previously been advertised by the North Fork Livestock Association; and


WHEREAS, said rodeo will be entirely sponsored by the North Fork Livestock Association as a private rodeo and the Association will be responsible for necessary police protection, liability insurance and clean up after the rodeo; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is agreeable to said request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the North Fork Livestock Association to use the new tribal Fair Grounds for the North Fork Livestock Association sponsored rodeo on May 31 and June 1, 1986.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that said authorization is granted with the understanding that the White Mountain Apache Tribe is not co-sponsoring said private rodeo and that the North Fork Livestock Association is solely responsible for security, liability insurance and clean up of the fair grounds after the Livestock Association Rodeo on May 31 and June 1, 1986.

The foregoing resolution was on May 27, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
