

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised and has been aware of ongoing problems involved in determining the eligibility of applicants for HIP Housing; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended by the Tribal Council Chairman to the Council that a three member committee comprised of one social worker from the Indian Health Service, one social worker from the Tribal Social Service, and one member at large be appointed to insure a professional evaluation of the eligibility and qualifications of applicants for HIP Housing; and

WHEREAS, it is suggested to the Council that the Chairman and Vice Chairman be granted the responsibility and authority to appoint the three-member committee described herein.


WHEREAS, it is further recommended that a salaried HIP Housing Coordinator be appointed to administer the HIP Housing Budget of \$113,906.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and grants to the Chairman and Vice Chairman, the responsibility and authority to appoint a three member HIP Housing Committee, comprised of one social worker from IHS, one social worker from Tribal Social Services, and one member at large for the purpose of providing professional evaluation and screening of eligible applicants for HIP Housing.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it approves the appointment of Beverly Stago as the administrator to coordinate the HIP Housing Contract.

The foregoing resolution was on May 27, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
