FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by the Tribal Council Secretary that it is necessary to reaffirm the Tribal Council Minutes of May 7, 1986, in order to conform to the Tribal Council Constitution which requires that said minutes be transmitted to the Bureau of Indian Affairs;

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council for good cause shown, agrees that said minutes should be reaffirmed.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms the Tribal Council minutes of May 7, 8, 1986.

The foregoing resolution was on May 27, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
