

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, members of the Tribal Council have been informed that a community rodeo schedule has not yet been developed for 1986; and

WHEREAS, not having a rodeo schedule has created conflicting scheduling of community rodeos; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has assigned Councilmembers Mr. Darvin Burnette and Mr. Herbert Tate to develop the 1986 Tribal Rodeo Schedule as to prevent any future conflicts with rodeo schedules; and

WHEREAS, a tribal member, Ivan Kitcheyan, has in the past prepared the annual rodeo schedules, and will serve as an Advisor to the development of the 1986 Tribal Rodeo Schedule; and


WHEREAS, Annual Rodeos previously established for East Fork on June 21, 22, and Cibecue for August 23, 24, be re-incorporated in the annual schedule.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Councilmembers Darvin Burnette and Herbert Tate are hereby directed to complete the 1986 Tribal Rodeo Schedule.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Ivan Kitcheyan is directed to serve as an Advisor in the development of the 1986 Tribal Rodeo Schedule.

The foregoing resolution was on May 21, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 2 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
