RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Anne Louise/Lucille Willie has requested Tribal Council assistance in granting a right-of-way so that essential utility telephone lines via underground cable can be constructed to their mobile home located in Alchesay Flat; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that there is ample room for the construction of utility telephone lines to the Willie home without transgressing on Mrs. Florence Dahkoshay's land as she has expressed some concern in respect to potential damage caused by trenching; and
- WHEREAS, in the event it is absolutely necessary to cross any part of Florence Dahkoshay's land for the purpose of constructing the utility lines to the Willie's mobile home, any damage or excess excavation to or on Willie's land will be completely restored to the state existing prior to said excavation.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants a right-of-way for the purpose of constructing a utility telephone line to the mobile home for Anne Louise/Lucille Willie.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in the event that it is necessary to cross Mrs. Dahkoshay's land for the purpose of extending utility lines to the Willie home, any disturbance or excavation resulting from construction of said utility lines shall be restored to the state existing prior to said excavation.

The foregoing resolution was on June 11, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
