WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by the HIP Home Coordinator, Ms. Beverly Stago, that it is imperative that the Tribal Council authorize the construction of HIP Homes in compliance with the HIP Housing Grant; and


WHEREAS, it is recommended to the Tribal Council that authorization be granted for construction of nine new homes rather than expend the housing program money on renovations of existing homes.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the expenditure of HIP Housing Program monies for the construction of nine new homes rather than expending said monies on renovation of existing housing.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman and in his absence, the Vice Chairman and any other necessary and appropriate tribal officials to execute any and all documents and contracts necessary to carry out the purpose of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on June 11, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
