

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, tribal member, Mrs. Luna Kessay, has appeared before the Tribal Council on behalf of her son and advises the Tribal Council that by prior resolution her son had received Council approval for a land assignment in McNary; and


WHEREAS, Mrs. Kessay requests that the Tribal Council reaffirm said resolution as the prior resolution cannot be located; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with said request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the land assignment requested by Henry Kessay, Jr., for a homesite in the town of McNary.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Chairperson of the Land Board to deliver forthwith to the Tribal Council Secretary a copy of the Land Assignment Application so that it may be included and attached to this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on June 19, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 11 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
