

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, review of prior grant and contract program budgets indicates that they have often exceeded their grant or contract budgets requiring the Tribe to subsidize the shortfall not covered by grants or contract monies; and


WHEREAS, due to the present financial dilemma of the Tribe such practices must immediately cease.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that all directors of grant and contract programs stay within their grantor or contract budget for FY 86/87.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby prohibits Central Tribe from subsidizing any grant and contract program in the event that said contract and grant program exceeds their approved budget.

The foregoing resolution was on JUNE 19, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
