

RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Tribal Council Member Ray Ivans from District IV has requested monies to renovate a building adjacent to the U.S. Post Office in McNary for local community meetings and Tribal Council use; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ivans is advised by the Tribe that \$3,000 has been budgeted for that purpose and that he is authorized to utilize those monies for renovation purposes.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes Councilman Ray J. Ivans to expend the pre-budgeted amount of \$3,000 for the purpose of renovating the building next to the Post Office in McNary for community and Tribal Council use.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i,k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
