


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE
OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is dedicated to improving and upgrading the economic functioning of all its members, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe Vocational Skill Center is the tribal entity charged with improving and upgrading the employability and employment skills of said members, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe Vocational Skill Center recognizes the specific needs of Tribal enterprises, agencies and programs, and
- WHEREAS, the Skill Center recognizes the special needs of physically, mentally and emotionally handicapped Tribal members, and
- WHEREAS, the Skill Center is a contract service provider with Arizona Department of Economic Security/Rehabilitation Service Administration, and
- WHEREAS, there is currently funding available for staffing and equipment for Work Adjustment Training and Job Development and Placement with the Arizona DES/RSA, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is the Tribal Governing Body, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council authorizes the Tribal Chairman to negotiate and execute grants, contracts and amendments thereto.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the Vocational Skill Center to submit a proposal to the Arizona Department of Economic Security/Rehabilitation Services Administration to improve the contract services for Work Adjustment Training and Job Development and Placement, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that, if funded, the Vocational Skill Center is authorized as the Tribal agency to administer the Employment-Related Program.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe, June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
