RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, by prior tribal Resolution No. 86-154, the Tribal Council requested the Chairman and Vice Chairman to recommend to the Council, names of persons to be appointed to an Advisory Committee whose functions would be to make eligibility recommendations for those persons to receive assistance pursuant to the Housing Improvement Program; and
- WHEREAS, the HIP Housing Coordinator has recommended that Charlene Hill from Indian Health Service Social Services, Bettina Begay from Tribal Social Services, and Vonda Clarkson from the Tribal Elderly Services Program be appointed as the Advisory Committee to make eligibility recommendations for recipients of the Housing Improvement Program; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council hereby approves the aforenamed persons; and
- WHEREAS, said Advisory Committee shall serve without pay in an advisory capacity only, and their recommendations shall be subject to final review and approval by the Tribal Council.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints the following persons to the HIP Advisory Committee:
 - 1. Charlene Hill, IHS Social Services
 - 2. Bettina Begay, Tribal Social Services
 - 3. Vonda Clarkson, Member at Large
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Advisory Committee shall serve in an advisory capacity only, without pay and their recommendations shall be subject to final Tribal Council review and approval.

The foregoing resolution was on JULY 10, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
