


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


- WHEREAS, The White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to have all Tribal members living in a safe, decent and sanitary conditions, and
- WHEREAS, For some members the only means to acquire a house is through the Bureau of Indian Affairs Housing Improvement Program, and
- WHEREAS, The White Mountain Apache Tribe has successfully contracted Housing Improvement Program with the Bureau of Indian Affairs under P.L. 93-638, and
- WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs requires a Resolution to recontract and
- WHEREAS, The White Mountain Apache Tribe does not foresee discontinuing of the Housing Improvement Program Contract.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the White Mountain Apache Tribe reapply for the Housing Improvement Program for the fiscal year 1986 and for each year thereafter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council, that the contract shall commence July 1, 1986, and terminate December 31, 1986, and that the Chairman or his representative is hereby authorized and directed to sign any and all documents necessary to consummate the Housing Improvement Program.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
