

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal Education Director Wesley Bonito has advised the Tribal Council that space is needed to accommodate free books donated to the Tribe by publishers for use by children ages Kindergarten through High School; and

WHEREAS, the great volume of books received pursuant to this program requires considerable space and Mr. Bonito, therefore, requests that Alchesay Hall be made available for that purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with this request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Wesley Bonito Director of Tribal Education Department to utilize Alchesay Hall as a storage area to stock the books donated and received pursuant to the publishers' free book program.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
