

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is the Governing Body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to recontract for Fiscal Year 1987, and each year thereafter for the Title VII Grant; and
- WHEREAS, the Title VII Grant Program has in the past, been successfully administered; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has authorized the Tribal Education Director to develop, plan, negotiate, execute and administer the contracts and/or any amendments thereto; and
- WHEREAS, the authority granted under this resolution to the Tribal Education Director shall run concurrent with the term of the Contract from October 1, 1986 to September 30, 1987 and each succeeding year thereafter.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Education Director is hereby authorized to plan, develop, negotiate, execute and administer the Grants and Education Funds and Contracts discussed herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman and in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, are hereby authorized and directed to sign the negotiated Educational Contracts for FY 86 and for each year thereafter the following program:

1. Title VII Program

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
