

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, this resolution pertains to approval of the fiscal year 1987 Forest Management Deductions Budget and Use Plan which is administered under authority of the Code of Federal Regulations 25, Subchapter H, Section 163 and Bureau of Indian Affairs Manual 53, Supplement 3, Section 6.6, and

WHEREAS, regulations require concurrence of the Forest Mangement Deductions Budget and Use Plan by the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council requests Bureau approval of the Fiscal Year 1987 Budget in the amount of \$550,000.00.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby concurs with the proposed Forest Management Deductions Budget and Use Plan for Fiscal Year 1987 and requests Bureau approval.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Forest Management Deductions collected will be properly deposited and expended on items designated in F.Y. 87 Budget and Use Plan and in accordance with 25 CFR and 53 BIAM.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
