

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that Nayland Gass an enrolled member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe did not receive his per capita distribution of the proceeds of the settlement of claims case 22-D because inadvertently his name did not appear on the tribal roll to receive said distribution; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that Mr. Gass should receive his share from other tribal funds regardless of the omission of his name from the tribal rolls that were established to distribute the Docket 22-D settlement to tribal members, and

WHEREAS, the Council is advised that Mr. Gass's share could be paid from tribal contingency funds.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Business Office to disburse to Nayland Gass the amount of \$805.00, from tribal contingency funds which represents his per capita share of the proceeds from the Docket 22-D settlement.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i, k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
