

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been informed that the Community of McNary is in need of temporary repairs to its water distribution system pending eventual replacement of the entire system pursuant to an FmHA grant, said temporary repairs being necessary to protect the health and safety of the approximately 640 residents of McNary, and in particular to prevent the immediate threat to the residents of McNary posed by the consumption of potentially contaminated spring water; and

WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$9,000.00 are currently available from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), pursuant to a Community Development Block Grant; and

WHEREAS, application for funds have been submitted by the Tribal Engineering Department and the Engineering Department has been advised by HUD that the funds are forthcoming upon compliance by the Tribe with additional grant requirements; and

WHEREAS, the requirements for receipt of the grant require that the Tribal Chairman sign a certification evidencing that the Tribe will comply with the regulations, policies, guidelines, and requirements with respect to the acceptance and use of federal funds for the McNary project; and

WHEREAS, an additional requirement is that the Tribal Council certify by Tribal Council resolution that the Tribe has complied with the HUD regulations found at 24 CFR §571.300(f) and §571.604, which regulations require citizen participation in the receipt and administration of the grant funds.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman and in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby empowered to sign any further documentation and certification necessary to complete the application for funding and thereby allow receipt of the funds and the completion of the temporary repairs to the McNary water distribution system.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby certifies that the requirements of 24 CFR §571.300(f) and §571.604 have been satisfied.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i&j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
