RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

COMPLETED

11 SEP 1986

WHEREAS, Mr. Devore Thompson a tribal member has requested approval from the Tribal Council of a transfer of land located near Forestdale from the Carrizo Livestock Association to Mr. Devore Thompson; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Thompson advises the Council that the subject tribal land would be used for business purposes and that the Land Board approves of said transfer; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that there is no existing conflict in respect to the transfer or to the use of said land by Mr. Thompson for business purposes.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the transfer of land from Carrizo Livestock Association to Mr. Devore Thompson, said land being located in the Forestdale area to be used for business purposes.

The foregoing resolution was on August 6, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (m) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
