WHEREAS, Mr. Thompson advises the Council that the subject tribal land would be used for business purposes and that the Land Board approves of said transfer; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that there is no existing conflict in respect to the transfer or to the use of said land by Mr. Thompson for business purposes.

Tribe that it hereby approves the transfer of land from
Carrizo Livestock Association to Mr. Devore Thompson,
said land being located in the Forestdale area to be used
for business purposes.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 6, 1986</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine for</u> and <u>zero against</u> by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (m) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
