RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

COMPLETED

11 SEP 1986

WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney advises the Tribal Council that an off-reservation salvage operator has been located who is willing to come on the reservation with a portable vehicle crusher to crush abandoned vehicles and is also willing to obtain titles for said vehicles and will pay the tribe \$3.50 per ton; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to implement the "Junk Yard and Abandoned Vehicles Ordinance"; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further desires to beautify the reservation by removing abandoned vehicles.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Tribal Attorney's office to make the necessary arrangements for the removal of abandoned and junk cars on the reservation, including but not limited to vehicles located in McNary, at the Broken Arrow Garage and throughout the reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on August 8, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
