RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

11 SEP 1986

WHEREAS, tribal member Delta Hinton has requested Tribal Council assistance to enable her to remain eligible for and to move into a HUD home; and

WHEREAS, she explains to the Tribal Council that the Housing Authority has requested that she relinquish her homesite in northeast Diamond Creek prior to moving into her HUD home at a different location; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council in order to accommodate Mrs. Hinton's request hereby authorizes a relinquishment of her homesite located in northeast Diamond Creek; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Hinton also requests that the Tribal Council transfer ownership of her northeast Diamond Creek homesite to tribal member Virginia (Hinton) Curtis and the Tribal Council agreeing to said request.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the relinquishment and transfer of ownership of Mrs. Hinton's northeast Diamond Creek homesite to tribal member Virginia (Hinton) Curtis and requests that Mrs. Hinton and Mrs. Curtis advise the Tribal Land Board and Land Office of said relinquishment and subsequent transfer of the homesite at Diamond Creek to Mrs. Curtis.

The foregoing resolution was on August 21, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
