RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

COMPLETED

11 SEP 1986

WHEREAS, sponsors of the AYUDA toy project have invited tribal representatives to attend a meeting of a local Elks Lodge in New Jersey, September 4, 5, 6, 1986; and

WHEREAS, said meeting will honor other American Indian Tribes as well; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that all expenses other than round trip airfare will be covered by the Elks Lodge; and

WHEREAS, six representatives from the Tribe have been invited; and, the Tribal Council concludes that three Council Members should attend as well as Medicine Man Paul Ethelbah, the newly crowned Miss White Mountain Apache and one child; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council hereby appropriates tribal funds necessary for transportation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby accepts the invitation of the Elks Lodge to send six representatives of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to New Jersey to attend the Elks Lodge function September 4, 5, 6, 1986.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Council Members Marjorie Grimes, Gertie Lupe, Judy Dehose and Medicine Man Paul Ethelbah, Miss White Mountain Apache 1986-87 and one child are hereby authorized to attend the Elks Lodge function, and further authorizes the expenditure of tribal funds for their transportation and other necessities to attend said function.

The foregoing resolution was on August 21, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
