RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

11 SEP 1986

WHEREAS, it has been determined that low-income families residing on the White Mountain Apache Indian Reservation spend a disproportionate high percentage of their income on energy; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is interested in applying for funds under the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) for fiscal year 1987 to assist eligible households; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been informed by the Home Improvement Administrator that there is no accessible Criteria/Guidelines, Eligibility Requirements and Procedures established for the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP).

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the attached Criteria/Guidelines, Eligibility Requirements and Procedures are hereby adopted for the administration of the Low-Income Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP).

The foregoing resolution was on August 21, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
