

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs Area Office is currently holding funds in the amount of \$50,000 for disbursement to those tribal employees who were employed by Development Enterprise on the Bonito Creek Road Project; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs Area Office refuses to release those funds to the Development Enterprise for disbursement to the affected tribal members until certain issues regarding the Tribe's Fringe Benefits Plan are resolved to the satisfaction of BIA Area Office and the Department of LABOR; and

WHEREAS, Development Enterprise has been requested on several occasions by the Tribal Attorney's Office to provide that certain information and as of to date has failed to comply with these requests and has, therefore, deprived the above referenced tribal members of their fringe benefit payments.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Scott Canty of the Tribal Attorney's Office is hereby directed and given full authority to review the records held by Development Enterprise concerning those tribal members employed by Development Enterprise on the Bonito Road Project and to enlist the aid of former Development Enterprise employee Erma Brown, and to coordinate his efforts with Randall Massey, Jr., employee representative, and with Russell Bradley, BIA Superintendent. Erma Brown should be temporarily rehired by Development Enterprise in order to assist in the compilation of the necessary information in order that this matter may be resolved as soon as possible.


The foregoing resolution was on September 10, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
