

RESOLUTION NO. 86-303

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal council has been advised by Paschal Johnson, Sr. an enrolled member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, that in order to complete acquisition requirements for a Farmer's Home Administration (F.H.A.) home he has acquired through bidding, a transfer of homesite lease encompassing 0.23 acres and know as the Elena Baha Homesite area must be transferred to his name; and

WHEREAS, the desired homesite being located in the Seven-Mile Community, and is more particularly described as a square plot of ground 100.0 feet east by west and 100.00 feet north by south lying in the NW 1/4 of Section 31, T5N R23E; Gila and Salt River, base and meridian; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of the existing lease and the Farmer's Home Administration (F.H.A.) require Tribal Council approval of such homesite lease transfer from the prior owner to the new owner, Mr. Paschal Johnson, Sr.; therefore he is requesting Tribal Council approval of such transfer of the Elena Baha homesite lease to his name.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the transfer of the Elena Baha homesite lease to Paschal Johnson, Sr., in accordance with the lease terms and the Farmer's Home Administration (F.H.A.) contract guidelines associated with said housing unit.

The foregoing resolution was on September 17, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
