WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been informed that tribal member Mary Ruth Bush has received Land Board approval for a homesite at North Fork near the Powerline Road; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been provided with the proper documentation from the Land Board concerning this matter, said documents being attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein.


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approves of the homesite assignment by the Land Board.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves of the homesite assignment for Mary Ruth Bush at North Fork based upon information and belief that there are no existing conflicts or disputes which would justify disapproval of the homesite assignment.

The foregoing resolution was on September 17, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
