

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Vice-Chairman's approved 1986 Fiscal Year Budget allocated the amount of \$20,000 for the purpose of a tribal vehicle for the Vice-Chairman's use; and

WHEREAS, the funds expended for said tribal vehicle amounted to \$2,467.79 less than the budgeted amount; and

WHEREAS, the Vice-Chairman has requested that the above savings on the capital expenditure for a tribal vehicle be transferred to the Vice-Chairman's travel account due to the extensive travel required by the Vice Chairman in the fulfillment of his official duties; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that it is necessary for the Vice-Chairman to travel on many occasions in his official capacity and in representation of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and that the above savings on the tribal vehicle purchase should be transferred to the Vice-Chairman's travel budget.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes a line item transfer in the amount of \$2,467.79 to be transferred from the Vice-Chairman's Capital Expense (001-003-7960) to the Vice-Chairman's Travel Expense (001-003-7704).

The foregoing resolution was on September 17, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 2 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
