

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, tribal member Zella Bread has requested Tribal Council assistance to resolve a land dispute between herself and tribal member Lyda Chino; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by interested parties that an agreement was reached to divide the land in half by Mrs. Zella Bread and Mrs. Lyda Chino, but that presently both parties desire the same half; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Zella Bread should be granted first priority in respect to the subject land because of her superior and prior ancestral claim to said land.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants to Mrs. Zella Bread first choice and prior right to the land presently in dispute between herself and tribal member Lyda Chino, based upon Mrs. Bread's ancestral claim to said land.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h), (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
