

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there are pending before the Land Board and Tribal Council many requests by tribal members for farmland assignments located within Livestock Association areas; and

WHEREAS, traditionally the Livestock Associations are consulted prior to the Tribal Council granting any farmland assignments within Association Range Lands; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the next general Livestock Association meeting regarding pending land assignment requests is not scheduled until February, 1987, which will cause undue delays in processing requests for farmland assignments.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs all Livestock Associations within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation to meet as soon as possible for the purpose of reviewing all requests for farmland assignments within their respective association range areas.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it directs the Livestock Associations to be prepared to present their recommendations in respect to tribal member requests for farmland assignments within their assigned ranges to the Tribal Land Board and Tribal Council as soon as possible to avoid processing delays.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and one against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h), (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
