

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, tribal members Janice, DOB: 09/10/64, and Linda Tortice, DOB: 01/06/61, daughters of Sid Tortice and Frances (Augustine) Tortice, have formerly requested that their tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so that they may become eligible for enrollment in the Tribe of their mother which is the TOHONO O'ODAHM, formerly the Papago Tribe of Arizona; and

WHEREAS, said relinquishment will be irrevocable if granted and therefore, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that the Tribal Chairman should request from Janice and Linda Tortice some assurance that the Papago Tribe will grant them membership prior to the Council granting their relinquishment request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Janice and Linda Tortice that their tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished contingent upon receipt by the Tribal Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe written assurance from Janice and Linda Tortice that their enrollment application for membership in the TOHONO O'ODAHM will be granted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs that upon receipt by the Tribal Chairman of a written statement from Janice and Linda Tortice that they will in fact be adopted into the TOHONO O'ODAHM Tribe that he issue an irrevocable relinquishment of tribal membership in the White Mountain Apache Tribe to both Janice and Linda Tortice.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of eleven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (s), (u) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
