

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been requested to appoint a five member Indian Education Committee whose purpose is to further Indian Education within and without the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, nominations have been made to serve on the committee and a vote by secret ballot has been concluded and canvassed; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said secret ballot the following persons have been elected to the Indian Education Committee:

Yvonna Redsteer
Marilyn Johnson
Vonda Clarkson
Mary Classay
Hedy Beatty; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing election is hereby approved by the Tribal Council.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the appointment of Yvonna Redsteer, Marilyn Johnson, Vonda Clarkson, Mary Classay and Hedy Beatty to the Indian Education Committee, to serve in said capacity until further notice from the Tribal Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that in the event any of the foregoing elected and appointed persons declines said appointment, the Council recommends to the remaining Committee Members that they consider those persons nominated, but not elected to the Indian Education Committee, the names of whom are in the Office of the Tribal Council Secretary.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of eleven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (r), (s)

of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
