

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised by Devore Thompson, an enrolled member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, that in order to complete acquisition requirements for two Farmer's Home Administration (F.H.A.) homes he has acquired through bidding, a transfer of the homesite leases formerly held by other tribal members must be transferred to Mr. Thompson; and


WHEREAS, the desired homesites are located respectively in the Seven-Mile Community, and in the Whiteriver Community and is more particularly described as follows:


- (1) Seven Mile Property: A parcel of land located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 31, T. 5 N., R. 23 E., Gila and Salt River Meridian in Navajo County, Arizona, containing 0.367 acre, more or less, described as beginning at the northeast corner of section 31, thence S. 51°52'W., a distance of 328.3 feet; thence S. 57°19'W., a distance of 292.4 feet to the true point of beginning; thence S. 79°33' W., a distance of 100.0 feet; thence S. 10°27'E., a distance of 160.0 feet; thence N. 79°33'E., a distance of 100.0 feet; thence N. 10°27'W., a distance of 160.0 feet to the true point of beginning, as described on the attached plot;
- (2) Whiteriver Property: A parcel of land located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 13, T. 5 N., R. 22 E., Gila and Salt River Meridian in Navajo County, Arizona, containing 0.230 acre, more or less, described as beginning at the northeast corner of sec. 24, T. 5 N., R. 22 E., thence S. 72°26'W., a distance of 575.2 feet; thence N. 30°02'W., a distance of 975.7 feet; thence N. 44°30'E., a distance of 742.8 feet to the true point of beginning; thence N. 59°52'W., a distance of 100.0 feet; thence N. 30°08'E., a distance of 100.0 feet; thence S. 59°52'E., a distance of 100.0 feet; thence S. 30°08'W., a distance of 100.0 feet to the point of beginning; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of the existing leases regarding these homesites and the Farmer's Home Administration (F.H.A.) require Tribal Council approval of such homesite lease transfer from the prior owner to the new owner, Mr. Devore Thompson.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the transfer of the foregoing described homesite leases to Devore Thompson in accordance with the lease terms and the Farmer's Home Administration (F.H.A.) contract guidelines associated with said housing units.

The foregoing resolution was on NOVEMBER 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 () of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
