RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal council is advised to appoint a five-member Roads Committee to represent tribal interests and to act as a liaison with the Bureau of Indian Affairs and to make such recommendations as are necessary for the improvement of the Roads system on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by secret ballot has conducted an election to determine the membership of the Roads Committee and has canvassed and approved the results of said election.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that pursuant to Council election it hereby appoints the following persons to the Roads Committee:

- Randall Massey, Sr.
- Herschell Gregg
- Linbert Cosay
- Juan Antonio
- Richard Yardley

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that in the event of any one or two of the foregoing persons decline the appointment for any reason that alternates Bowman Daley and Leslie Walker may be selected by the Roads Committee to fill said vacancy or vacancies.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and one against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i), (s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
