RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESEPVATION

WHEREAS, the Rammed Earth Housing Project has been delayed for various reasons; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the appropriate paperwork be processed and that the Rammed Earth Housing Project obtain approval to begin construction as part of the ongoing HIP Program; and

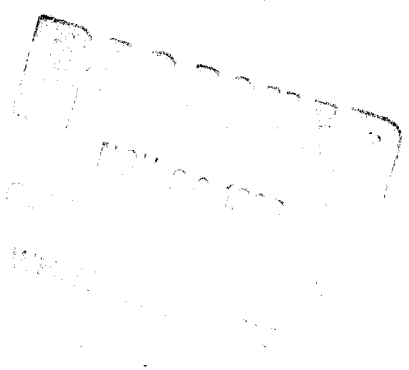
WHEREAS, Council Member Judy Dehose is familiar with said project and in the past has been granted responsibility to obtain Bureau of Indian Affairs approval for said project; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the BIA is requiring additional documents to be processed for the Rammed Earth Home proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Mrs. Dehose should be granted a period of thirty days in which to process the necessary paperwork prior to beginning construction of the Rammed Earth homes.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests Mrs. Judy Dehose to process all of the documents necessary to begin construction of the Rammed Earth Houses within thirty days.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of eleven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
