RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal members Mrs. Zonie (Lupe) Hinton and Mrs. Carla Alchesay Nachu have requested Tribal Council approval for homesites the location of which is set forth in detail in their respective land assignment applications which are attached to this resolution and incorporated by reference herein; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that there are no conflicting cliams to the area designated by Mrs. Hinton and Mrs. Nachu; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council sees no legal reason why the land assignment should not be requested.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the land assignment requests of Mrs. Hinton and Mrs. Nachu.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Land Board to enter in its files appropriate records of these two land assignments.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 2 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
