RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is a federally recognized tribe organized under and pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is mandated within its constitution and bylaws to promote the social and economic development of its constituents, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes that the Bureau of Indian Affairs will allocate Economic Development grants for Fiscal Year 86/87, in the amount of \$250,000.00, and


WHEREAS, the Director of Operations and Planning staff, with Tribal Councils approval is hereby directed to formulate the FY 86/87 Economic Development Grant for the specific purpose of funding the "New" Motel/Restaurant - Hondah Commercial Complex, and


WHEREAS, that the Director of Operations and Planner complete the technical aspects of the Economic Development Grant in coordination with the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council approves and supports the above efforts by:

1. Authorizing the Director of Operations and Tribal Planner to aggressively pursue and complete the FY 86/87 Economic Development Grant proposal in the amount of \$250,000.00 on the projected development of "New" Motel/Restaurant - Hondah Commercial Complex.
2. Authorizing the Tribal Chairman to request funds and sign necessary supporting documents in accordance to proposal.

The foregoing resolution was on November 7, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of five for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, Pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
