

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is dedicated to improving and upgrading the economic status of all its members; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe Vocational Skill Center is the major tribal entity charged with improving and upgrading the employability, employment skills and basic educational skills of said members; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe Vocational Skill Center recognizes the specific needs of Tribal enterprises, agencies and programs; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is the Tribal Governing Body; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council may authorize the Tribal Chairman to negotiate and execute grants, contracts and amendments thereto.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Vocational Skill Center to submit a proposal for Educational Services for Indian Adults for FY 87-88.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that, if funded, the Vocational Skill Center is authorized as the Tribal agency to administer said grant proposal (Educational Services for Indian Adults).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the Chairman, and in his absence his authorized representative, to negotiate and execute any and all documents necessary to carry out this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on November 7, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe,

ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

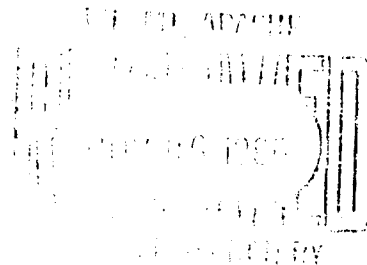
