RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESEPVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the Whiteriver Volunteer Fire Department is in need of a Tribal Liaison so that necessary safety programs and training can be coordinated and implemented; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Broadus Bones was the former Liaison Officer for the Fire Department and performed an exemplary job but that said position is now vacant; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended to the Tribal Council that Mr. Ray J. Ivans and Mr. Darvin Burnette safety officers for the Tribe perform this liaison service so that the Volunteer Firemen can receive proper training and have an open communication with the tribal government.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby assigns Mr. Ray J. Ivans and Mr. Darvin Burnette, Safety Officers of the Tribe, to the Liaison Officers with the Whiteriver Volunteer Fire Department for the purposes set forth in this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on November 7, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
