

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that the Arizona Department of Transportation desires to construct a new bridge spanning the Salt River, at the bottom of the Salt River Canyon on U.S. Highway 60, the northerly section of which bridge shall have its foundation supports located on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that the new bridge will substantially increase the safety and traffic flow across the Salt River; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that it is necessary for the Arizona Department of Transportation to conduct certain archaeological and geologic testing in order to finalize the location of the proposed bridge and its approaches, and it being necessary to provide the Arizona Department of Transportation with essential permits from the tribe in order to conduct such archaeological and geological testing.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Arizona Department of Transportation is hereby authorized to enter upon the White Mountain Apache Reservation for the limited purpose of conducting archaeological and geologic testing in order to ascertain the final location of the proposed new bridge spanning the Salt River.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Tribal Chairman's Office is hereby authorized to issue letters of permission to the Arizona Department of Transportation and its consultants in order to facilitate the necessary testing.

The foregoing resolution was on November 14, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of five for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the

Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
