


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mr. David Moore, a graduate student attending the University of Arizona, has requested Tribal Council permission to conduct a study to assess the performance of White Mountain Apache students attending colleges and universities over the past five to ten years; and
- WHEREAS, a copy of the research design is attached to this resolution and incorporated by reference herein; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Indian Education Committee has reviewed the research design and discussed the project with Mr. Moore and endorses said study; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that permission should be granted to Mr. Moore pursuant to the research design, with special emphasis on the approach aspect of the design paper which provides that the research will be conducted in close cooperation with Mr. Wesley Bonito, the Tribal Higher Education Director, and that after the research is completed, a copy of the final document will be made available to the Tribal Council before being submitted to the University of Arizona Center for the Study of Higher Education.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to Mr. David Moore to conduct the research described in the attached research design proposal.

The foregoing resolution was on December 3, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of FOUR for and THREE against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b)(a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
