

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESEPVATION

WHEREAS, Council Member Darvin Burnette advises the Tribal Council that Resolution No. 85-55, attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein, approved a request from the East Fork Community for the construction of a fence around the East Fork Graveyard in order to protect small children from wandering into the graveyard, and for the preservation of that sacred area; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Burnette is requesting federal revenue sharing funds to accomplish that purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes after some discussion that it is necessary that a survey be conducted of the graveyard to determine the construction cost of a fence around the graveyard so that proper public hearings can be noticed in respect to allocating revenue sharing funds for said purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council requests that Mr. Burnette utilize the services of Mr. Raymus Albert, Director of the Tribal Land Office, to conduct the survey, and the Council further requests that Council Member Burnette provide a cost estimate of said fence and that Mr. Burnette then schedule appropriate public meetings in conformity with the revenue sharing laws and regulations.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request of Council Member Darvin Burnette for the utilization of revenue sharing funds for the construction of a fence around the East Fork Graveyard, pending formal public meetings to be noticed by Mr. Burnette in conformity with the federal revenue sharing regulations.

The foregoing resolution was on December 3, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i)(j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
