

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Health Authority has entered into prior contracts with Indian Health Services for Health Services funded under P. L. 93-638, the Indian Self-Determination Act; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Health Authority assumes direct administrative responsibility over the following programs as part of said contract:


1. Community Health Representative
2. Emergency Medical Services
3. Health Education
4. Alcoholism Treatment Program; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Health Advisory Board will review the Tribal Health Authority's proposal for recontracting prior to submittal of said proposal.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council it is supportive of the Tribal Health Authority's efforts to recontract with the Indian Health Services in an effort to provide comprehensive health services on the Fort Apache Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby designates the Tribal Chairman or his authorized representative to act in the capacity of contract negotiator on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for the Health Authority Programs named above with the Phoenix Area Indian Health Service.

The foregoing resolution was on DECEMBER 3, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b), (i), of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
