

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 86-360 passed on November 14, 1986, the Tribal Council directed that a proposed amendment to Ordinance No. 60 be posted for a period of at least ten days for public comment as required by the Tribal Constitution in the form attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council Secretary advises the Council that the proposed Ordinance has been posted for the requisite constitutional term; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney advises the Council that there has been no opposition to final passage of said ordinance in the form attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that said Ordinance should be finally enacted.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves final passage and enactment of the amendment to Ordinance No. 60, in the form attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby designates the amendment to Ordinance No. 60 as Ordinance No. 153, and directs the Tribal Council Secretary to distribute copies of this Ordinance to the Tribal Court, Police Department and Tribal Business Office.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i & o) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
