

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by prior resolution directed the Tribal Attorney's Office to assist Mr. and Mrs. Kay Lewis in their claim against Stratton Brothers Construction Co., for damages to their home arising out of blasting activities during construction of a sewer line by Stratton Brothers and their subcontractor; and

WHEREAS, said legal services were provided at no cost to Mr. and Mrs. Lewis' but with the understanding that the cost of expert witnesses necessary to establish a claim would be paid from the proceeds of any recovery with the Lewis' to retain the balance thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney's Office has obtained a settlement from the insurance company for the damages to the Lewis' home and said settlement has been tendered to the Lewis; and

WHEREAS, there remains outstanding a debt owing to Western Technologies Inc., which firm rendered services necessary to establish the claim, said services being valued in the amount of \$2,500 which amount the Tribal Council concludes should be paid from the proceeds of the insurance settlement forthwith; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney's Office has made repeated request to Mr. and Mrs. Lewis for the payment due to Western Technologies but that to date no payment has been received.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby directs the Tribal Attorney's Office to recover from Mr. and Mrs. Kay Lewis by whatever means it deems necessary, the funds owing to Western Technologies, Inc., in the amount of \$2,550.


