FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised there exist a vacancy on the BIA Agency School Board due to the resignation of a Board member and the Tribal Council is desirous of appointing a person to the School Board who is presently serving on an educational school board within the reservation; and


WHEREAS, Mr. Jerry Gloshey is presently serving on the Whiteriver District School Board and it is recommended to the Council that he be appointed to fill the vacancy on the BIA School Board; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs in this recommendation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Mr. Jerry Gloshey to the BIA School Board.

The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 4 for and 3 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
