

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, pursuant to a prior resolution accepted a donation of several thousand toys from a New Jersey organization for distribution to children living on the reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, in addition to the distribution of these Christmas toys, wishes to distribute Christmas candy to the children and the elderly at the same time; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of consolidating these efforts and saving distribution costs, the Office of the Chairman has volunteered to distribute the gifts and candy to the children and the elderly, and the Tribal Council is in agreement that this would be the best means to distribute the same.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby agrees that the Office of the Tribal Chairman should be responsible for the distribution of toys to children and Christmas candies to children and elderly residing within the reservation and to those tribal member handicapped children and elderly residing in rest homes outside the reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
