

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by the Bureau of Indian Affairs that members of the Tribal Council are invited to attend a Multiple Land Use and Comprehensive Planning workshop to take place at the Bureau Agency on December 9 and 10, 1986; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the meeting is to outline a Bureau proposal that the Tribe and the Bureau of Indian Affairs cooperate in preparing a Comprehensive Multiple Land Use Plan for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that tribal representatives should attend said meeting for informational purposes only.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby accepts the invitation of the Bureau of Indian Affairs to have tribal representatives attend the December 9, 10, 1986 discussions hosted by the Bureau of Indian Affairs regarding a Comprehensive Multiple Use Land Plan for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
